The Lenten focus on Sunday morning is on "Signs of the Kingdom." We will look at different signs of the Kingdom of God Jesus demonstrated in his ministry.

<u>March 3</u>: Third Sunday in Lent- We will celebrate Holy Communion, and we will baptize Ann Todd Roberts, daughter of Dr. Amanda and William Roberts. The scripture will focus on Jesus *healing* a crippled woman as he showed her compassion for her suffering.

<u>March 17</u>: Fifth Sunday in Lent- Jesus tells us that the greatest commandment of all is *love*: Love of God above all, love of neighbor, and love of self.

<u>March 24</u>: Palm Sunday- We celebrate the Triumphal Entry of Christ into Jerusalem as we sing our *praise* to Christ.

<u>March 28</u>: Maundy Thursday Service- We will join with St. Luke UMC at their church as we remember the Last Supper and the admonition of Jesus to "do this in remembrance of me." This service is at **6:00 p.m.** at St. Luke UMC

<u>March 29</u>: Good Friday- We will host the Tenebrae Service at First UMC as we remember the suffering and death of Jesus Christ on the *Cross*. This service is at **6:00 p.m.** at our church.
